A former preschool music teacher by day and indie rocker by night, Laurie Berkner began selling her music more than ten years ago out of her living room on her own label, Two Tomatoes Records. Laurie was the first artist to ever appear in music videos on Nick Jr., Nickelodeon’s 24-hour educational, commercial-free, pre-school network, and is featured in nearly all of the episodes of the channel’s “Jack’s Big Music Show.”
