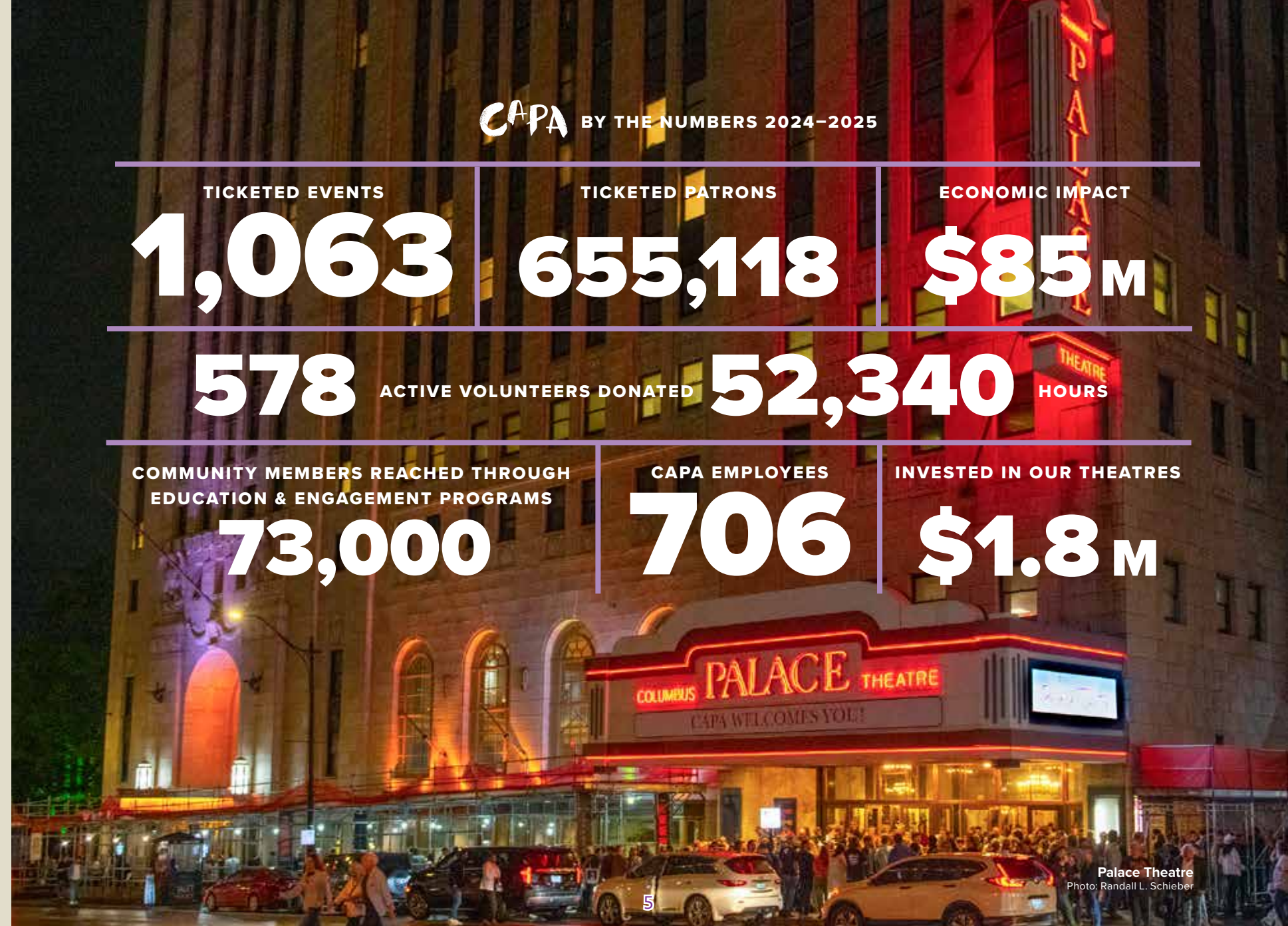
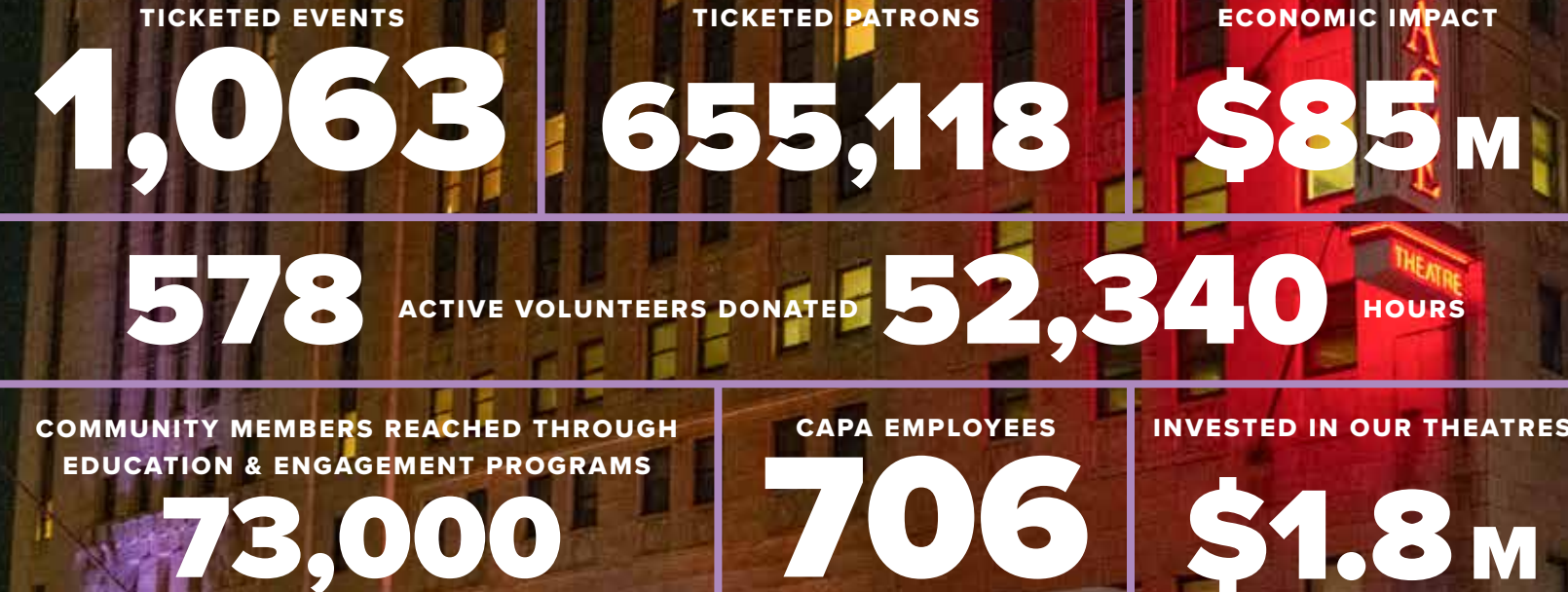

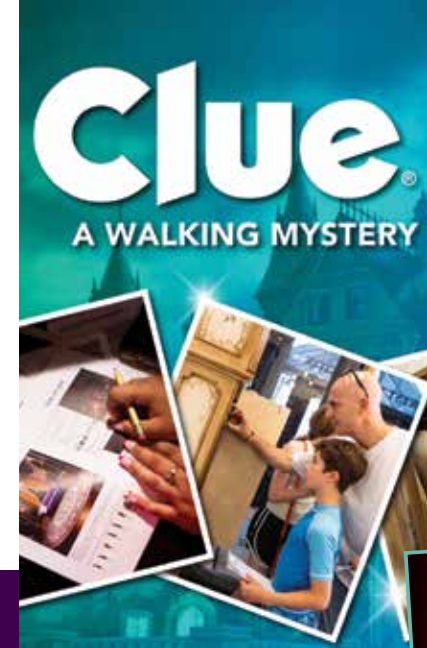

2025 was the third summer of our intergenerational storytelling through the arts program, **ARISE (ARts through Intergenerational Social Engagement)**, a collaboration between CAPA, GrowIN, and The Ohio State University. The program connects teen scholars, undergraduate volunteers, and older adults, using creative mediums such as drama, dance, visual arts, and songs to tell stories, build new relationships, and find connections across generations.

In November 2024, the Center for HumanKindness at The Columbus Foundation named **ARISE** a HumanKindness Prize honoree. The HumanKindness Prize recognizes nonprofits that exemplify unwavering and intentional human kindness in action.

In February 2025, **ARISE** earned certification as a “Program of Distinction” by Generations United.

In July 2025, a research study centered on **ARISE** was published in the *Journal of Intergenerational Relationships*.



CAPA presented the fourth annual **Cinema Columbus Film Festival** over five days in April–May, screening 51 films (our highest number to date), in partnership with seven venues throughout the community.

Cinema Columbus was named the No. 1 Film Festival in *USA Today's* 2025 Readers' Choice Awards.

WEST SIDE STORY



WEST SIDE STORY

A highlight of the season was a new production of *West Side Story* in February, co-produced by BalletMet, CAPA, Columbus Symphony, and Opera Columbus. All four performances sold out, with over 10,000 individuals in attendance.

The collaboration between four of Columbus's leading performing arts organizations created a *West Side Story* like no other, with 52 orchestra musicians, 28 dancers, and 22 performers. This was *West Side Story* performed on a grand scale, created in Columbus and for Columbus—nearly all of the artists were local to central Ohio.

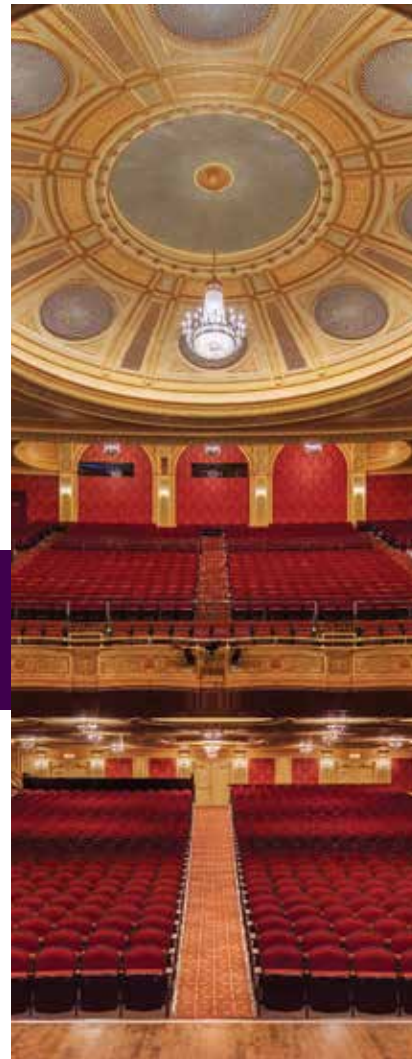

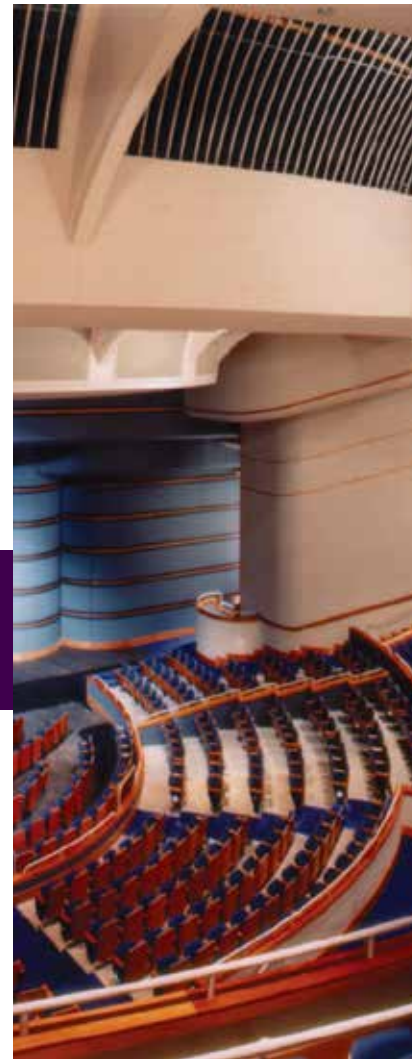

VOLUNTEERS

Dedicated volunteers help CAPA to fulfill our mission every year. Ranging in age from 16 to 80+, some live just around the block, while others drive over 50 miles to serve our patrons and community.

PROJECT ACCESS

In December 2024, CAPA announced “Project Access,” a continual improvement program to expand accessibility offerings and initiatives in our theatres.

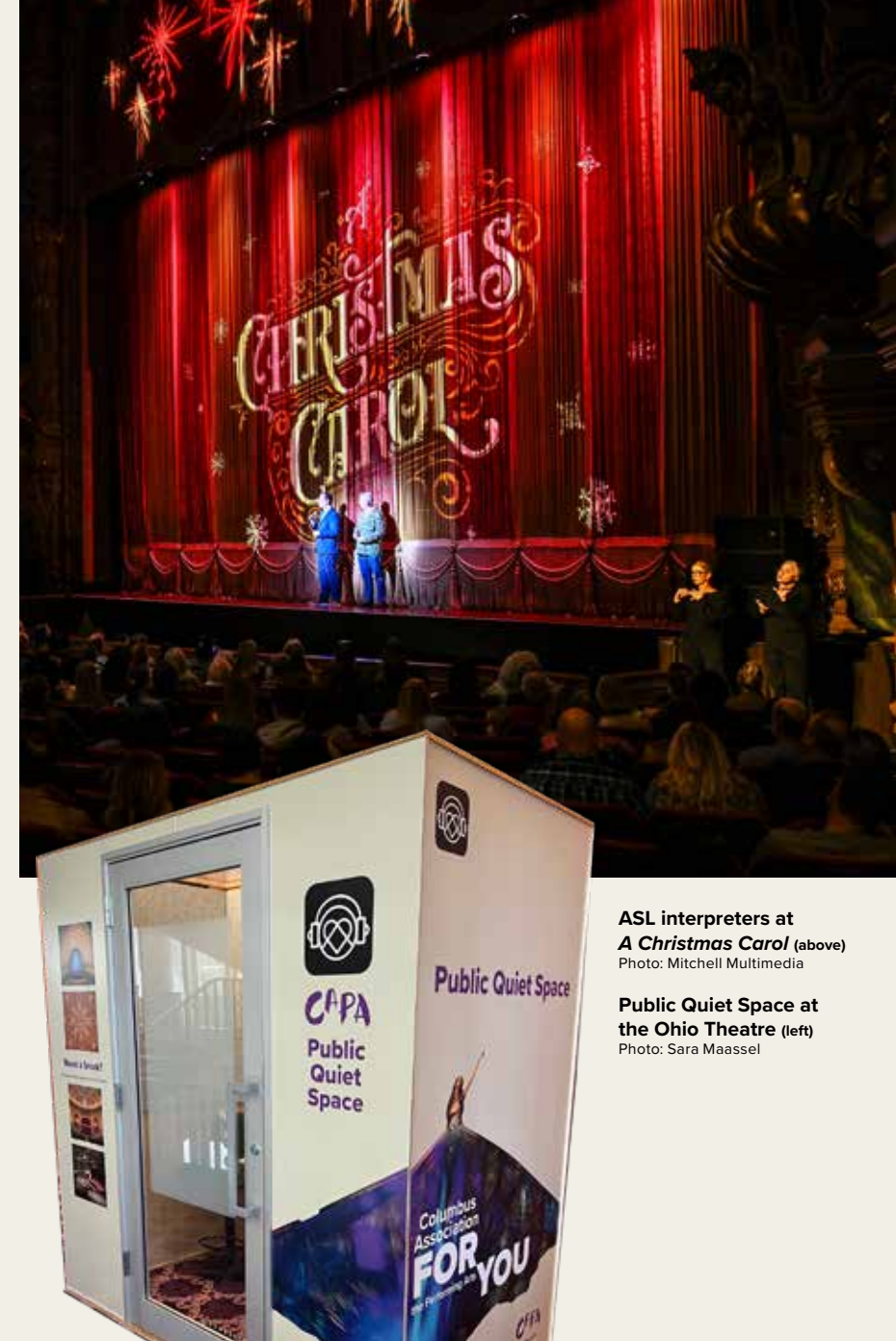

Recent updates in our theatres include state-of-the-art assistive listening technology, accessible family restrooms with universal changing tables in the Ohio and Riffe Theatres, and certification of the Ohio, Palace, Southern, and Lincoln Theatres, Riffe Center Theatre Complex, and the McCoy Center with KultureCity, a leading national nonprofit organization dedicated to promoting inclusivity and accessibility for individuals with sensory needs. This partnership includes newly installed signage at CAPA venues to designate quiet areas, headphone zones, and sensory inclusive locations. Free sensory bags, which include fidget tools, noise-cancelling headphones, and feeling thermometers, are available in all of our venues. CAPA staff and volunteers are provided with continuous training, and our venues are available on the KultureCity app.

In 2024–25, CAPA launched two groups that support access: an internal staff Accessibility Team and an Access Advisory Committee with ADA experts and members of the public. Both groups work to make the patron experience at CAPA venues better for everyone. CAPA also collaborates and builds relationships with ADA groups like Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities, and ADA Coordinators at the State of Ohio, City of Columbus, and The Ohio State University.

CAPA is proud to have presented 7 open-captioned shows, 26 audio-described shows, and 33 ASL-interpreted shows over the past year.

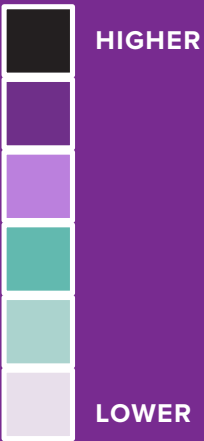

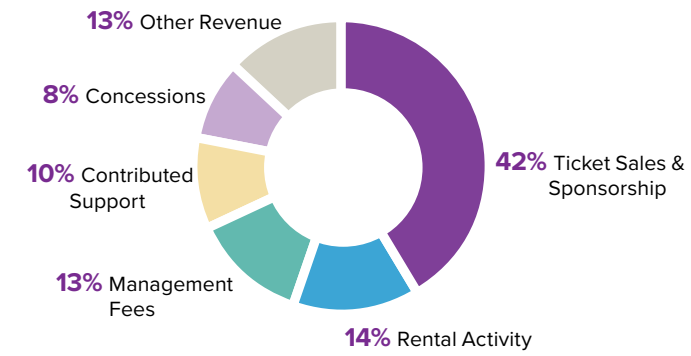


CAPA attracts patrons from all of Ohio's 88 counties. The map highlights ticket sales that include patron zip code data.

OPERATING EXPENSE (Columbus only) \$29.7 M

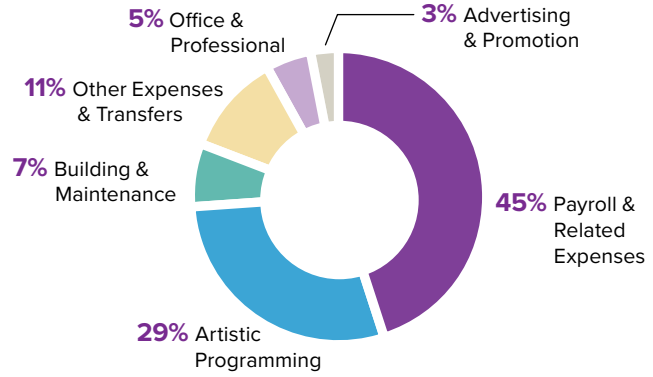
