PNC Broadway In Columbus had another incredible season, with sold-out runs of *Six* and *Beetlejuice* and the Columbus homecoming of Nina West in *Hairspray*.

With incredible seasons, come incredible subscribers. In 2022–23, we were able to award more than \$46,000 in ticket subsidies, thanks to our subscribers' donations. These contributions made it possible for more than 1,288 students and teachers from 22 schools in 11 school districts from eight central Ohio counties to see Broadway shows, many for the very first time.

Education & Engagement



CAPA Marquee Awards

In the fifth annual CAPA Marquee Awards presented by American Electric Power Foundation, 18 schools participated, reaching 2,356 high school students. Throughout the year, students participated in a series of free master classes and workshops with local and regional artists and touring Broadway company members from *Hamilton*, *Hairspray*, *Elf*, *Six*, and *Beetlejuice*.

The 2023 CAPA Marquee Awards Showcase presented by American Electric Power Foundation was held at the Ohio Theatre on May 25. There were 167 student performers and technical crew members who worked

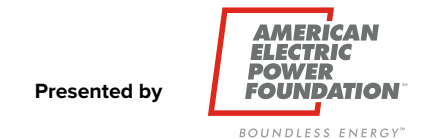
on the red-carpet event, which included the announcement of winners in each category and included performances from the nominees for Best Musical Production and Best Performer in a Leading Role, as well as opening and closing numbers that incorporated students from all participating high schools. Congratulations to Pickerington High School North on winning the 2023 CAPA Marquee Award for Best Musical Production for *Kinky Boots*!

In June, Helena Engberg (Olentangy High School) and Christian Strong (Pickerington High School North) received a CAPA-sponsored trip to New York City to represent the CAPA Marquee Awards and central Ohio at the 2023 Jimmy Awards.® For nine

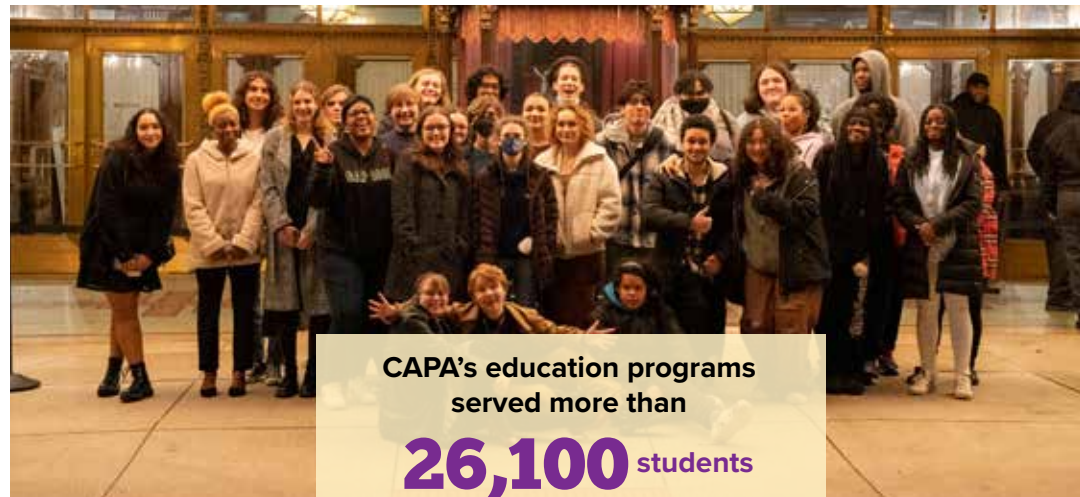
days, they joined top musical theatre students from across the country for private coaching, master classes, and rehearsals in preparation for a special showcase performance at the Minskoff Theatre on Broadway on June 26, 2023.

Passport To Learning

CAPA marked its 12th season presenting matinee performances for students in grades Pre-K-12, and this year we awarded a total of \$10,434 in scholarship and transportation assistance for our four in-person productions.

9,793 students were also registered to experience our two virtual arts experiences, *Mermaid Theatre of Nova Scotia's Puppets in Paper* and *Finding North*. Thanks to the generosity of our donors and sponsors, these programs were offered free of charge.

Social Justice Series

As part of CAPA's commitment to fight systemic racism in our community, we presented our second annual Social Justice Series. Productions included *On Golden Wings*, *Finding North*, *Step Afrika!*, and *Cenicienta: A Bilingual Cinderella*.

Broadway for Kids Applause Program

Thanks to the generosity of our Broadway subscribers, we awarded \$46,150 in subsidies and provided 1,794 students and teachers with the opportunity to attend *Hamilton*, *Hairspray*, *Six*, and *Beetlejuice*.



Broadway in the Classroom

This year, we launched Broadway in the Classroom, which provides Title 1 schools with the opportunity to engage in six weeks of curriculum developed around a Broadway show.

For this year's pilot program, teaching artists made weekly visits to Columbus Alternative High School and worked with 50 students on curriculum centered around the musical *Six*. On January 27, students travelled to the Ohio Theatre for a performance of the show, and a talkback with the cast and production team.

Community Outreach

In October 2022, as part of our Social Justice Series, we had a weeklong engagement with *On Golden Wings*, an interactive living history play which tells the story of James

Herman Banning and Thomas Cox Allen, the first African Americans to fly across the United States.

To share this inspiring story, we travelled to Worthington Christian Village for a performance for their residents, the Reeb Center for an audience that included youth from The Boys and Girls Club of Central Ohio, and West High School, where a group of students rehearsed and performed a musical number alongside the cast during a performance for the entire school. Finally, we made our way to the Lincoln Theatre for a community day which included a pre-show paper airplane flying contest complete with prizes, a performance of the show, and a talkback with the cast.

El Día De Los Niños

On April 30, we welcomed more than 240 guests to the Lincoln Theatre for a free cultural celebration. The event included a performance and instruction by Ballet Folclórico Xochihua, crafts, balloons, and a Milagro Intention Wall created by Columbus Museum of Art. Afterward, we invited everyone to a free performance of *Cenicienta: A Bilingual Cinderella*.

KIMBERLY MINOR

IN PROFILE

Q HOW DID YOU FIRST GET INVOLVED WITH CAPA?

A I was an audience member at CAPA and had planned events in the theatres with other groups that I was involved with in the 90s, but I wasn't on the other side of the organization. When I moved back to Columbus, Lynnnda Davis asked about my interest in being a CAPA Board Member. I had done a lot of supporting the arts and my son had become engaged in Columbus theatre, so it was a natural fit! I love everything that CAPA does, and it keeps getting better!

Q WHAT DOES CAPA AS AN ORGANIZATION AND ITS ROLE IN THE COMMUNITY MEAN TO YOU?

A CAPA is the glue of the creative community by managing all these different venues and making it possible for performing artists to have world-class spaces to create in. When you walk into any of the theatres, you feel welcomed and safe, and it's beautiful. CAPA also partners with other people and organizations, like with the Common Ground Series at the Columbus Commons. That's what an arts organization

should bring to the community, those opportunities to come together and to grow through experiencing something that makes you feel good.

Q WHY DO YOU BELIEVE THAT AN ARTISTIC PRESENCE IN OUR COMMUNITY IS IMPORTANT?

A I grew up in the arts. My family always believed that they are your foundation and that you can use the arts to think about life in a very creative way. And creativity is not always the person who can draw. Creativity is thinking, seeing the world as a better place, and meeting new people from many different walks of life. In the arts, you have to be inclusive because you are usually collaborating with others. I just can't imagine a world without the arts.

Q WHAT DOES THE MARQUEE AWARDS PROGRAM BRING TO THIS COMMUNITY?

A The Marquee Awards program brings possibility. I'm getting chills thinking about it! It brings this sense of "Wow! I did that. I can do more" to growing artists and the chance for

young people to see their peers up on the stage doing what they love and what they excel at. So, I think the Marquee Awards program is an incredible preface to the rest of life.

Q WHY DO YOU DONATE AND GIVE YOUR TIME AND TALENTS TO CAPA?

A If I can bring light to any experience or organization as a result of how I've lived and my experiences, then I want to do it, especially to an organization like CAPA that is feeding the community every day. So if I can pour in as you pour out, then I have something to be proud of and my legacy will live on!

KIMBERLY MINOR is a CAPA Trustee and member of the CAPA Education Committee. You may have seen her onstage recently presenting one of the awards during the 2023 CAPA Marquee Awards with her son Carter, a former Marquee Award nominee. We sat down with her and asked her about CAPA; the Marquee Awards program; and why she supports CAPA with her time, talent, and treasure.

CINEMA COLUMBUS

CAPA presented the second annual **Cinema Columbus Film Festival** over five days in April, featuring over 40 screenings, including narrative, documentary, local feature and short films. Cinema Columbus partnered with 10 different central Ohio venues for festival screenings.

The opening night jazz celebration featured the documentary *Hargrove*, and the festival featured world premieres of locally-produced feature films *MID WEST* and *Duranguito*, plus several sold-out short film blocks featuring many central Ohio filmmakers. Other highlights included audience choice award winner *Anchorage* (director Scott Monahan), narrative feature jury award winner *B-Side: For Taylor* (director Christina YR Lim), documentary feature jury award winner *Perhaps What I Fear Does Not Exist* (director Corine Shawi), and short film jury award winner *Lunchbox* (director Anne Hu).

CAPA again teamed up with the Columbus Downtown Development Corporation (CDDC) for free Common Ground concerts at the Columbus Commons. Touted as “big

names at no charge,” the series hosted country star Martina McBride and R&B legends Boyz II Men. “The Common Ground concert series at Columbus Commons

brings the community together in the heart of Downtown Columbus in a way that cultivates connection through an incredible shared experience,” said Taylor.

FESTIVAL LATINO

PRESENTED BY HONDA

Festival Latino marked its 26th year in 2023. Massive and high-spirited crowds filled Genoa Park for the two-day festival, enjoying an entertainment lineup that included national headliners and local artists, food, children's activities, art, and dance from the heart of Latin America. The free, family-friendly festival is the largest of its kind in Ohio.

For the second year, a free dance party, presented by American Electric Power, kicked off the weekend at Lower.com Field, home of the Columbus Crew.

Participants in the Mercadito Raices program, a partnership with the Ohio

Small Business Development Center and the Our Lady of Guadalupe Center, were recognized. These nine new businesses completing the program, designed to give Latino entrepreneurs valuable training and tools, opened for business for the first time at Festival Latino. And, for the first time in 2023, the Festival hosted a dominoes tournament with DICO (Dominicans in Columbus, Ohio).

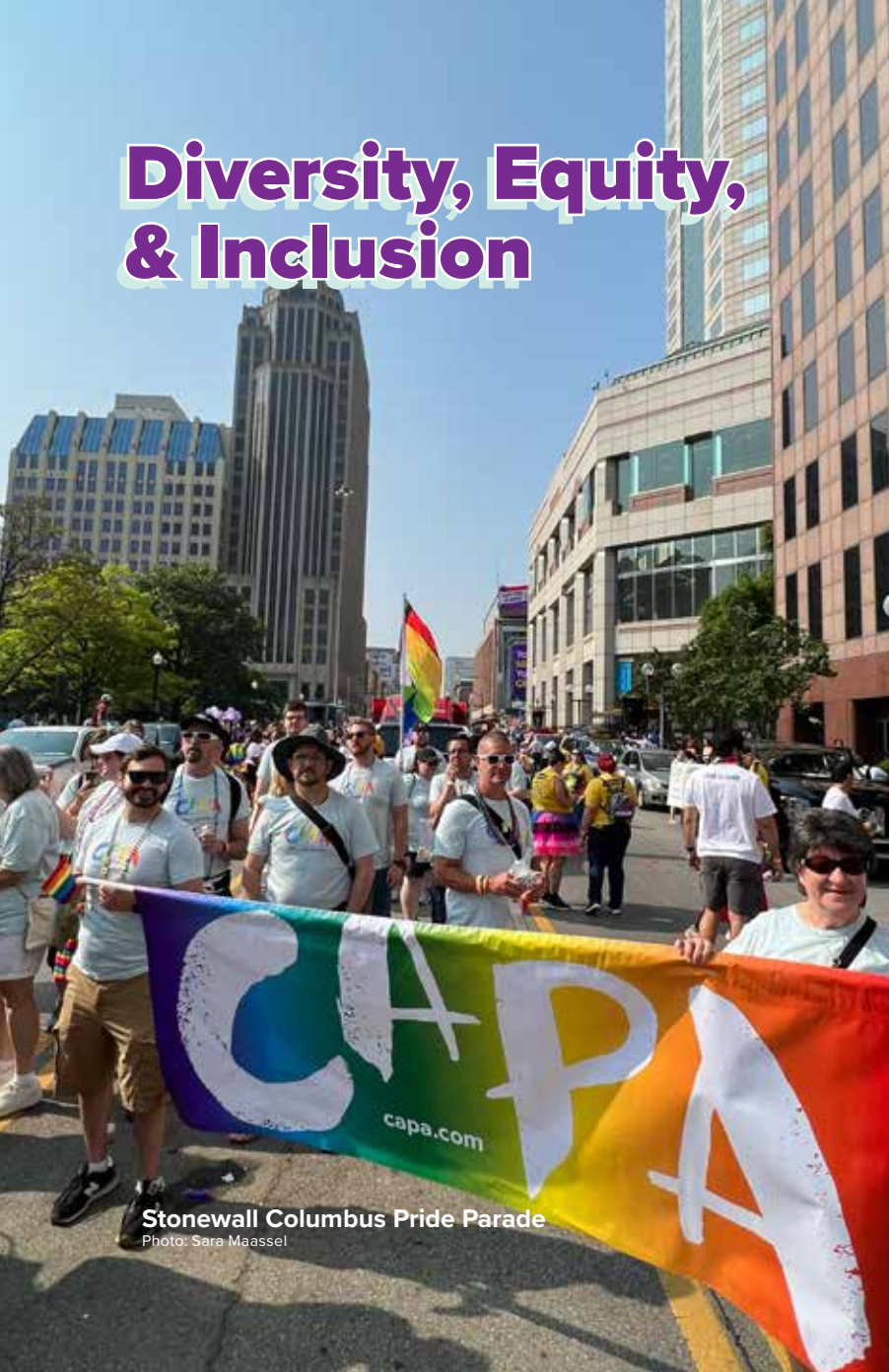

CBUSArts Ticketing

CBUSArts, a ticketing service powered by CAPA, serves the sales needs of resident groups and other presenters in CAPA venues, in addition to other select venues. CBUSArts provides enhanced customer relationship management tools specifically designed for arts organizations. Launched in 2019, CBUSArts is 100 percent local and fees support CAPA's mission-driven initiatives designed to make Columbus a national destination for the performing arts.

CAPA Trick-or-Treat More than 1,200 adults and children donned costumes to attend the first Trick-or-Treat at the Palace Theatre, a free community event. Guests explored the Palace—including the stage, auditorium, and areas usually closed to the public—collecting treats, tricks, candy, and activities at stations along the way. As classic cartoons played on screen, kids learned about and interacted with rescue animals, and took photos with familiar characters like Batman and Pocahontas. This special event allowed central Ohio residents to experience the Palace Theatre in a new light (or, in many cases, for the first time)!

UPDATED AIR HANDLER—OHIO THEATRE

A new air handler was installed in the Ohio Theatre dressing room tower. This air handler serves the dressing room and backstage areas, replacing one that was installed in 2003.

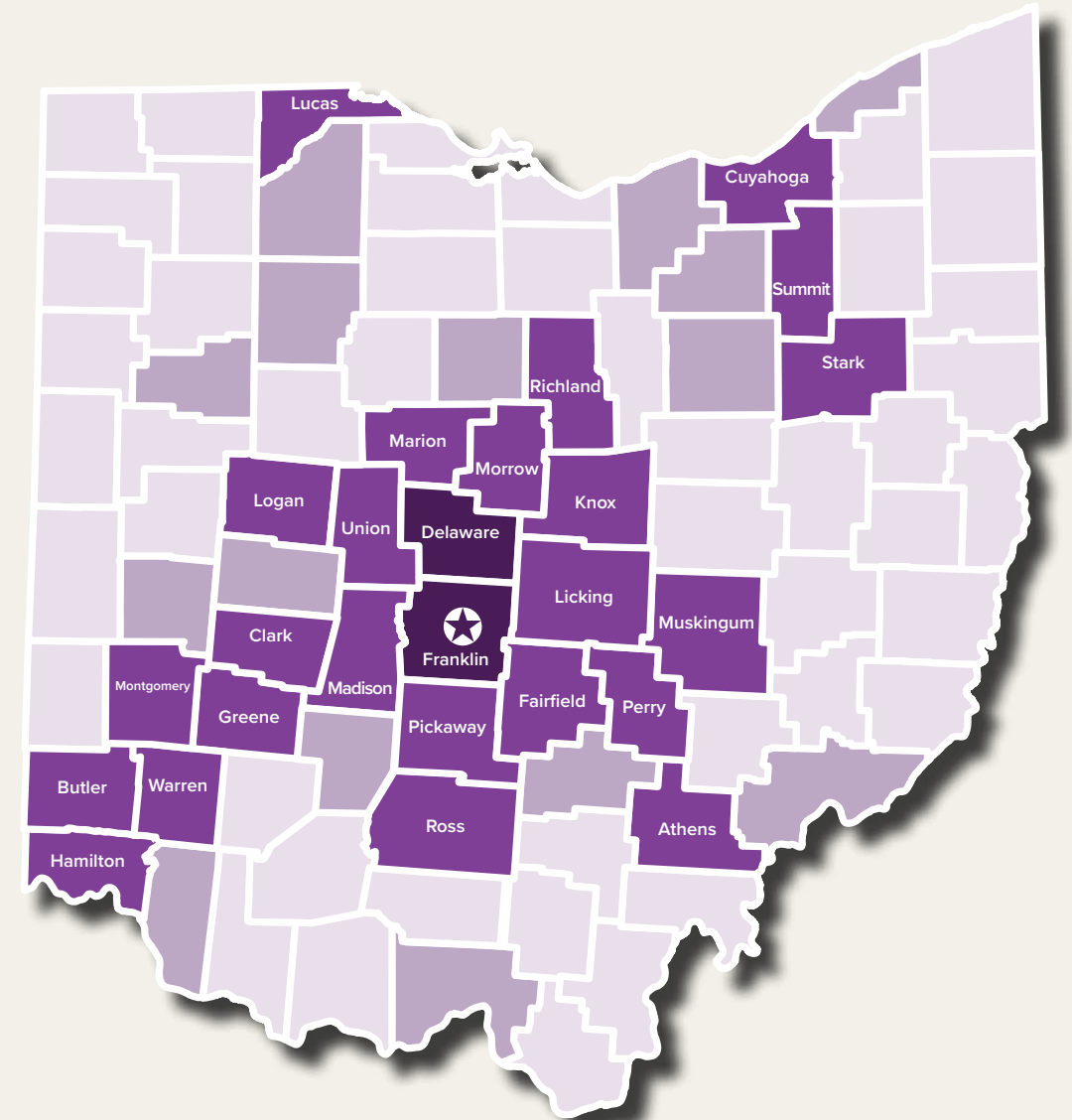

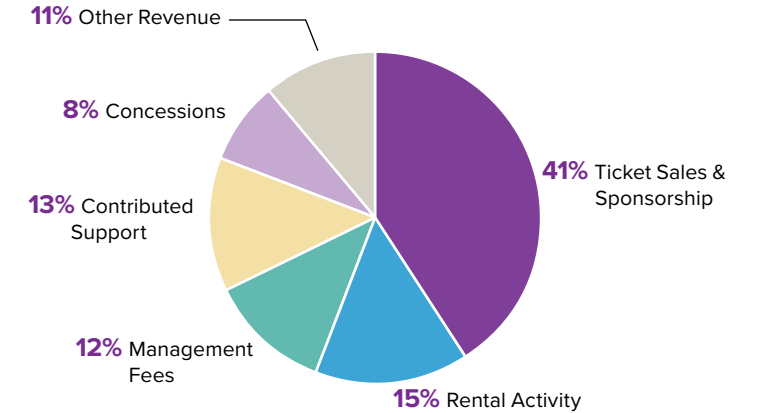

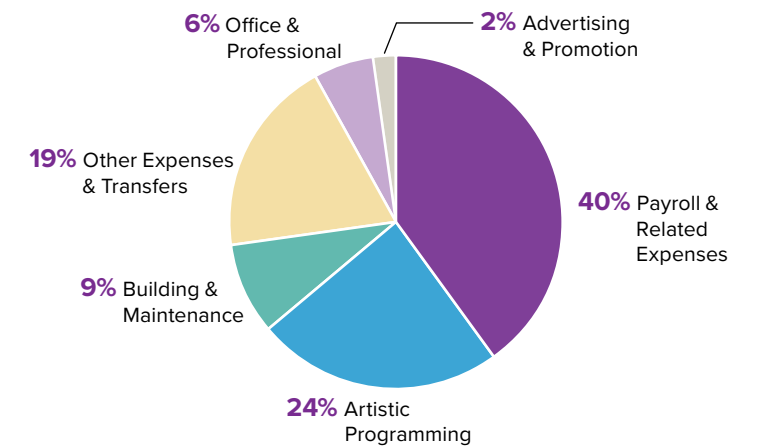
Payroll and Related Expense and Artistic Programming remain the largest expense items for CAPA, comprising over 64% of the operating expenditures for Fiscal 2023. Charitable purpose related expenses were 73% of total operating expenses for the year.
