

## Columbus Symphony Community Concerts Public Health Safety Protocols and Guide September 2020

### Safety Protocols

- Face masks are required by all audience members while at the performance space.
  - To ensure your safety, all staff members and volunteers will wear face masks for the duration of your visit.
- All audience members will have their temperature taken upon arrival. Those with a temperature of 100.4+ will not be permitted into the performance (as recommended by CDC guidelines).
- Please practice social distancing from those outside of your household by staying 6 feet apart.
  - This includes social distancing while seated for the performance. Ground markers will help navigate the appropriate spacing for families.
- You will be ushered to your socially distanced seat(s). At the end of the performance, the usher will dismiss you.
- Please make use of the hand sanitizer stations near the entrance at your discretion. This is recommended after coughing, sneezing, touching your face, etc.
- Please do not attend the performance if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms or have been in contact with anyone presenting symptoms in the last 14 days.

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### Reminders

- Gates open 30 minutes prior to the performance.
- Bring a chair or blanket to relax while you enjoy the 45-minute performance.
- Concerts do not include an intermission.
- Lavatory facilities will not be available onsite.
